G. Verdi: Requiem: choir fugue no. 7 "Libera me, Domine", measure 186 – 245 (Peters edition)

J.S. Bach: Matthew Passion: BWV 244 choir I from the 1st choir part "Kommt ihr Töchter, helft mir klagen", measure 17 – 26 (Bärenreiter edition)

J.S. Bach: St. John Passion: BWV 245 final chorale

A. Bruckner: Locus Iste

A. Schönberg: Friede auf Erden from fig. 3 to fig.6 as marked (our pianist will play the other vocal parts)

Sight reading and vocal exercise can be part of the audition as well as ensemble singing. Also you can be asked to read some lines in foreign languages.

Memorization is optional.
